After your Co-Coach assignment, you will meet with the Program Director to discuss your experience and receive your Lead Coach assignment.



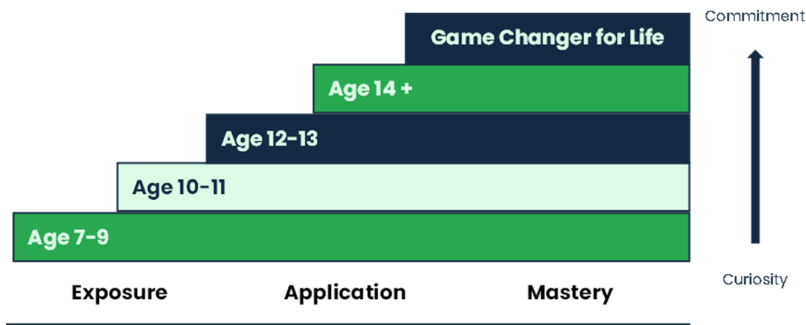

First Tee Program

Our trained coaches not only provide an introduction to junior golf and an opportunity to enhance golf skills, but they also create a safe, supportive, and empowering environment to help kids prepare for life ahead, including friendships, school, college and even their careers.

Age-Based Program

At each age group, participants engage with the 5 Key Commitments while focusing on mastering golf fundamentals and building upon a golf skill foundation as they advance within the program.



Coach Advancement

- **Level 1:** Emphasizes instruction for the 7-9-year-old age group and beginning First Tee coaching strategies.
- **Level 2:** Emphasizes instruction for the 10-13-year-old age group and intermediate First Tee coaching strategies.
- **Level 3:** Emphasizes instruction for the 14+-year-old age group and advanced First Tee coaching strategies.

Lead Coach Responsibilities

- Leads and oversees for entire program delivery at the location including station set up, lesson plan delivery, participant check-in/out, risk management, and clean up.
- Manages all coaches on site at that time including Assistant and Junior Coaches.
- Provides emergency response accountability for participants and adults on site.
